6. 2016 Chateau Haut-Battailey, Cinquièmes Grand Cru Classe, Pauillac, Bordeaux, France. Deep, dark, almost opaque, purple-red color. The aromas are slightly earthy, with, concentrated black-cherry fruit. The wine is fresh & supple with a very fine tannic structure that gives a little grip. There is a lovely vibrant blackcurrant fruit on the mid-palate with a chocolatey texture & cocoa hints. Alcohol is balanced & the wine is of mid-weight.
