- A Biodynamic sparkling wine with zero chaptalization which no dosage of sugar was added during the fermentation process. The nose is fruity and relatively gourmand. It reveals notes of white peach and pineapple combined with a touch of lemon and a slight touch of apricot to nicely enjoy as an aperitif or even with Le Fromage.
